## ***Rules and conditions***

### ***Chiltern and Thames Rider Showing Qualifier Rules***

Horse and Ponies who have qualified for or competed at HOYS (except SEIB Search for a Star), Royal International Horse Show or Olympia in the years 2007, 2008, or 2009 are not eligible for the C&T Rider Championships.

This includes non-qualifier classes at RIHS also. Thoroughbreds who qualify for the the ROR finals at Hickstead also cannot qualify for our championships, again in the years 2007, 2008, 2009. This Championship is aimed at keen and competitive amateurs, not professionals.

Stallions must be handled and ridden by people who have attained their 14th birthday on 1st January 2009.

Please do enter qualifying classes if your horse or pony is not eligible. You will get spotted. For the past two years we have had to disqualify a horse and pony which is embarrassing and causes a lot of problems.

Passports must be available for inspection if asked for by a judge or official of the show.

Qualification can pass down the line - as far as 4th place. There must be five or more competitors in the class for the qualification to pass down below 2nd place. Judges do not award Q cards or sign cards. Correct reporting of the results of each class, passed onto CT Rider by the show secretaries will suffice. CT Rider will then award the qualifications as per our rules and inform the competitors. All riders who want to be eligible to qualify must be CT Rider Members. New memberships for the 2009 season are now on sales and can be purchased on line by visiting [www.chilternrider.co.uk](http://www.chilternrider.co.uk) or by ringing CTR offices on 01582 748981/2.

### ***Rules for Shires Chiltern & Thames Rider Show jumping Qualifiers***

Riders must buy their membership numbers from C&T Rider prior to the competition at a cost of £12. Riders cannot qualify if they do not have a membership number. They can buy on line by visiting [www.chilternrider.co.uk/Membership/showmembers.htm](http://www.chilternrider.co.uk/Membership/showmembers.htm) Their numbers will be issued automatically so there is no need to wait for our office to issue a number. Alternatively riders can call the office and order their number over the phone by calling 08702 241263. CT Rider will confirm the riders who have qualified by sending them a letter and entry form for the final. CT Rider will pay for the postage for the mailing of the schedule or alternatively, email it to qualified riders. The benefit to riders is that they will not have to send an sae.

**Please note: Riders can only enter a maximum of 2 consecutive classes at the final e.g Mini & Novice or Novice and Intermediate or Intermediate & Open.**

## **Rules and conditions**

### **Style & Performance**

#### **Senior style and performance qualifier**

Open to riders aged 18 years & over on 1st Jan 2009 with any breed or type of pony/horse, 4 years of age and over.

#### **Junior Style & Performance Qualifier**

Open to riders aged 17 & under on 1st January 2009 with any breed or type of pony/horse, 4 years of age and over. Riders not to have reached their 18th birthday on 1st Jan 2009.

**All sections** to be judged 40% turnout of horse/pony and rider (total 40 marks), 60% performance in the form of a freestyle show. No marks for conformation.

Freestyle show to be held in an area approx. 20m x 40m and is to include the following movements:

Halt, walk on a long rein, trot serpentine, lengthened trot strides on diagonal, canter figure of eight (riders can complete an S shape, i.e. canter on each rein only once), extended canter on diagonal (total 60 marks) = 100 max score  
Riders must not execute the required movements more than once. The individual show should be short and flowing.

Please note, dressage whips are not permitted and children are not allowed to wear spurs. The tack and turnout of the horse/pony should be appropriate to the type of horse/pony being presented. The rider should dress appropriately for the type of horse/pony being presented. Dress code as per affiliated showing classes does not have to be strictly adhered to - the overall impression is of most importance. Flower pots will be used to mark out the corners of the arena at the final.

### **Royal London Show Qualification**

First, second and third placed horses/ponies in classes:

10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 19, 20 (reg only) 21, 22, 23, 24, 29 and 30 (reg only) 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 40, 41.

will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the Royal London Show in 2009. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Royal London Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the International Showing Society within 28 days of the qualifying show. No horse registration is required.

### **Tring & District Horse Association Rules and Conditions of Entry**

1. The Committee, Landowners and agents shall not be liable for any claim in respect of damage or accident to any person, animal, vehicle or property in any way whatever.
2. Dogs must be on leads at all times.
3. Any person riding on the showground must wear a hat conforming to PAS 015 or EN1384 with chinstrap fastened.
4. Whips must not exceed 30" in length.
5. Horses and ponies competing in ridden classes must be 4 years or over.
6. Objections must be made at the Secretary's tent within 30 minutes of the incident accompanied by a deposit of £20 which will be forfeited if the objection is overruled.
7. The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without giving a reason.
8. The judge's decision is final.
9. The Committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate any class.
10. Prize money will be awarded according to entries. Prize money must be collected from the Secretary's tent. Any prize money not collected on the day of the show will be deemed to be a donation to TDHA.
11. A special rosette/medal will be awarded to the highest placed member in each class. To be eligible members must carry their membership cards with them in the ring.
12. Ages are as at 1st January 2009. It is competitors' responsibility to familiarise themselves with the rules of the qualifiers to ensure that they are eligible. A full set of rules for C & T qualifiers will be available for inspection at the Secretary's tent.
13. Membership subscriptions must be paid by the date of the show for points won at that show to count for year end awards.
14. Correct riding attire must be worn in all classes other than gymkhana and handy pony where competitors must wear hats (see rule 3), jodhpurs and riding boots.
15. In consideration of our Landlords please take your litter home or use the bins provided. No mucking out of vehicles on the showground.
16. Competitors must take care when entering classes that may clash as no refunds will be given.
17. No cheque will be accepted without a valid bankers' card.
18. Equine passports must be available to the secretary upon request and a JMB height certificate may be requested in the event of a complaint.
